
First, read the passage and examine the figures and data, then answer the questions.

Frogs and other amphibians can serve as indicators of environmental health because some unique characteristics make them more susceptible to contaminants in the environment. Traits that can affect their vulnerability include the fact that...

- most amphibian eggs are coated in a jelly-like substance and do not have the protection of a shell;
- some scientists believe that a tadpole's immune system shuts down during metaporphosis; and
- adult frogs can absorb oxygen and water (and any pollutants they contain) through their skin.



Last year, the ratio of number of eggs laid: number of tadpoles hatched in Lake Timicau was 17,112:16,988.
